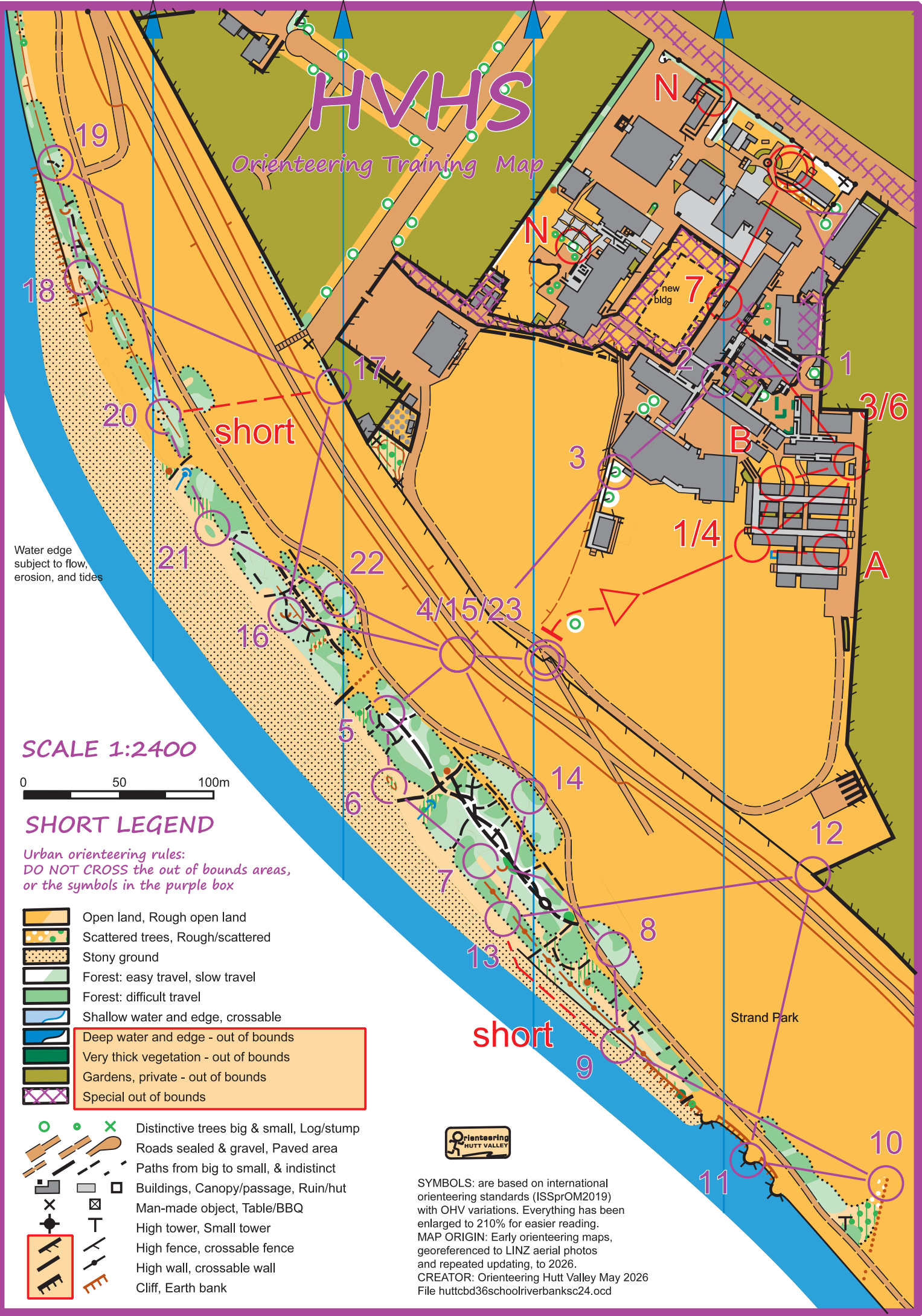

SHORT LEGEND

Urban orienteering rules:
DO NOT CROSS the out of bounds areas,
or the symbols in the purple box

- Open land, Rough open land
- Scattered trees, Rough/scattered
- Stony ground
- Forest: easy travel, slow travel
- Forest: difficult travel
- Shallow water and edge, crossable
- Deep water and edge - out of bounds
- Very thick vegetation - out of bounds
- Gardens, private - out of bounds
- Special out of bounds

- Distinctive trees big & small, Log/stump
- Roads sealed & gravel, Paved area
- Paths from big to small, & indistinct
- Buildings, Canopy/passage, Ruin/hut
- Man-made object, Table/BBQ
- High tower, Small tower
- High fence, crossable fence
- High wall, crossable wall
- Cliff, Earth bank



SYMBOLS: are based on international orienteering standards (ISSprOM2019) with OHV variations. Everything has been enlarged to 210% for easier reading.
