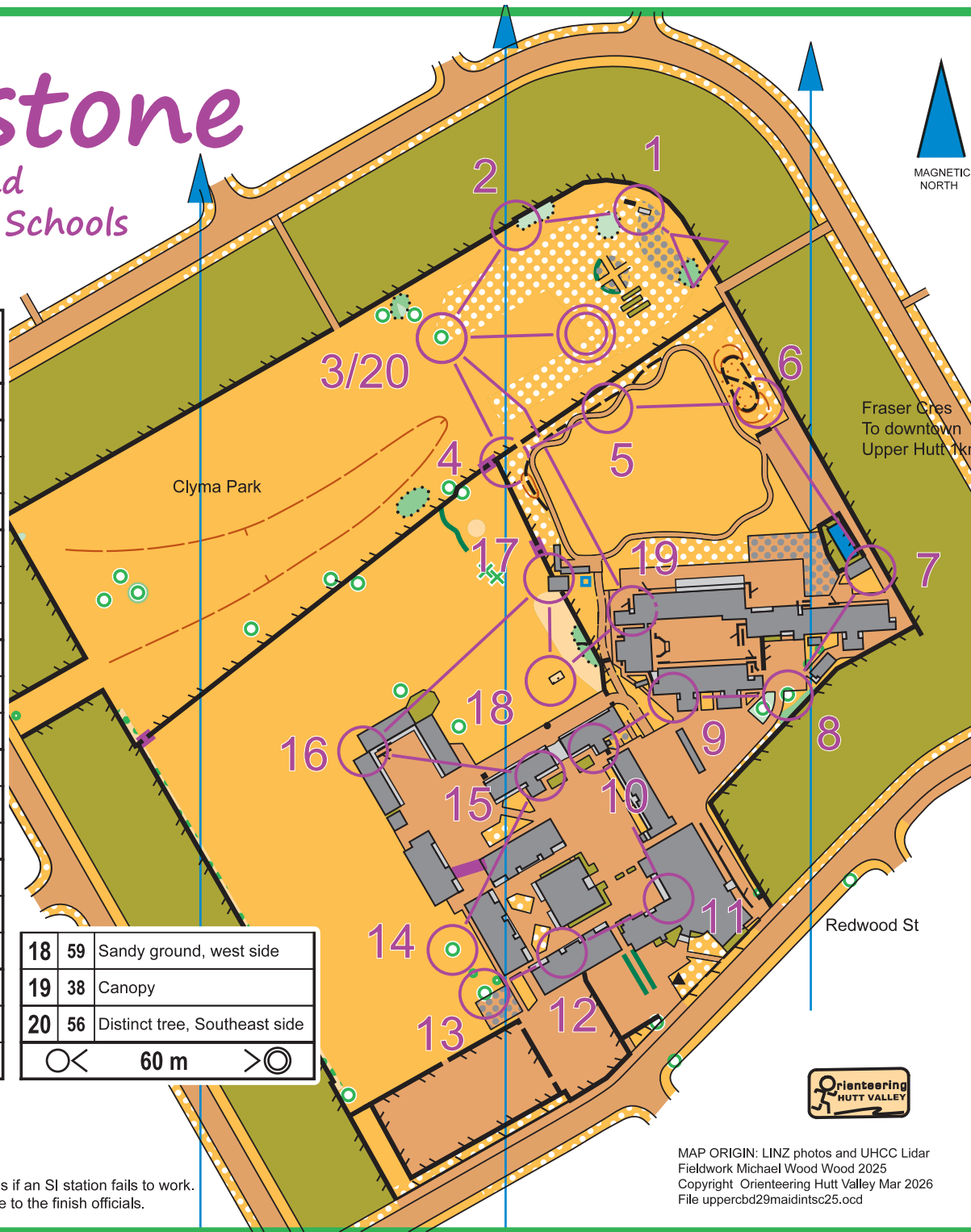

**DO NOT CROSS** out of bounds areas, or the symbols in the purple box

- Open land, Rough open land
- Scattered trees, Rough/scattered
- Stony ground
- Forest: easy running, slow running
- Undergrowth: slow running
- Forest: difficult to run
- Undergrowth: difficult to run
- Shallow water and edge, crossable
- Deep water and edge - out of bounds
- Very thick vegetation - out of bounds
- Gardens, private - out of bounds
- Special out of bounds
- ... sometimes edged like this
- Distinct vegetation boundaries

- Contour, Form line, Steep bank
- Small knolls, Depression, Pit
- Small ditch, Streams, Pond
- Water tank, Trough, Culvert
- Marshes
- Distinctive trees big & small, Log/stump
- Boulder, Group of bldrs, Monument
- Roads sealed & gravel, Paved area
- Paths from big to small, & indistinct
- Steps, Bridge, Model railway
- Area passable at two levels
- Buildings, Canopy/passage, Ruin/hut
- Man-made object, Table/BBQ
- High tower, Small tower
- High fence, crossable fence & point
- High wall, crossable walls
- High linear object, crossable lin object
- High cliff, passable rockface
- Railway, Crossing point
