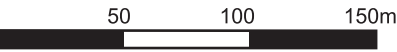


Orienteering Map of

- You may use these areas:
- Open land, Rough open land

 - Paved area

- DO NOT use or cross:
- Private, Garden, Unmapped
 - Specially thick vegetation
 - Special Out of bounds
 - River
 - Out of bounds road
 - High fence, High wall
