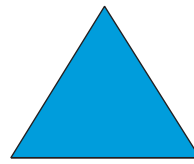

ORIENTEERING

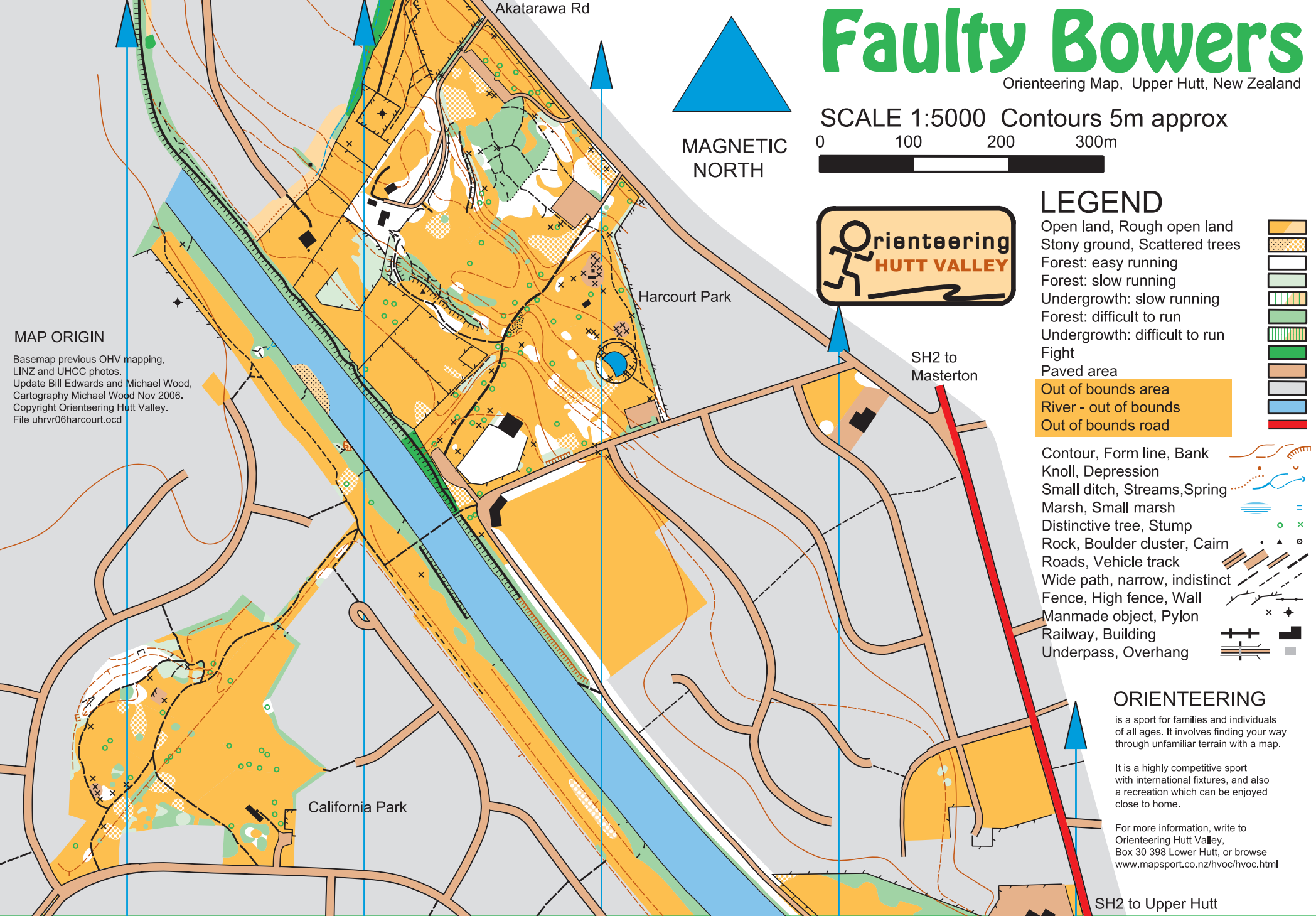
is a sport for families and individuals of all ages. It involves finding your way through unfamiliar terrain with a map.
